A Man With A Dream

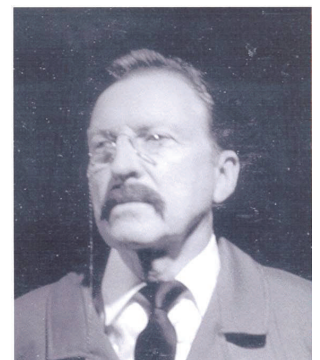
